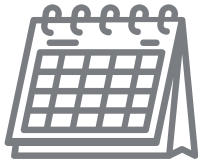


Vintage



A cool, dry start in 2022 delayed growth in Santa Lucia Highlands, but summer warmth spurred recovery. A September heat wave and low yields prompted staggered harvests, yielding a rich, concentrated wine.

Sight



Light Ruby Red

Nose



Ripe, forward aromas of raspberry liqueur, cherry, and red currant, enhanced by notes of caramel, graham cracker, roasted mushrooms, and sage.

Palate



Medium-full bodied, offering rich flavors of ripe black cherry and red currant, layered with hints of new leather, toffee, and fresh tobacco.
